To be used for temporary export of UW "Tools of Trade" items

Export Administration Regulations

The Export Administration Regulations (EAR) control the export of items listed on the Commerce Control List (CCL). It has been determined that the item stated below is listed on the CCL and is controlled to your destination.

The EAR, however, makes an exception to export license requirements for the temporary export or re-export of certain tangible items, software, or technology for professional use as long as specific criteria, to which you are certifying below, are met.
